



The Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) Contract Tracer will call all contacts of anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, determine exposure, assess symptoms, refer for testing according to established protocols, and provide them with instructions for isolation or quarantine.

RSVP Contact Tracers will maintain ongoing communication with contacts to assess symptoms, ensure compliance with quarantine and determine social support needs and/or handle reporting of issues that arise. RSVP Contact Tracers are required to follow set scripts and adhere to policies and procedures provided by state and local partners. They will also comply with requirements regarding confidential information related to personal information.

RSVP Contact Tracers will volunteer under the leadership and supervision of the State of Colorado, who will organize them into teams that are then allocated according to demand at the city and county level. RSVP Contact Tracers will report directly to team leads at the city and county level who manage groups of 5-10 tracers, complementing work that has been ongoing since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic. RSVP Contact Tracers will volunteer in collaboration with the Case Investigator from the local health department. This position will involve serving in a position of trust with members of the public, and may require a background check completed by a state agency.

Contact Tracers will serve through Volunteers of America Colorado RSVP, and will be supervised by a local health department in Colorado.

RSVP Contact Tracers will volunteer 6 to 20 hours a week. RSVP Contact Tracers will commit to volunteering for at least 8 weeks after training. RSVP Contact Tracers will begin in Mid-August and continue onboarding for as long as needed.

Senior Corps-RSVP is one of the largest volunteer networks in the nation. Volunteers use the skills and talents they have learned over the years or develop new ones while serving in a variety of volunteer activities in their community. Applicants must be 55 year of age or better to apply.
