*After opening on July 1, 2015, the Veteran Services Center has seen significant growth in interest from Veterans seeking assistance and providers seeking collaboration. The following is some information collected in the first year of operation from partner agencies providing free services.*



## Capital Campaign

Raised \$2.12M of a \$2.14M capital campaign to renovate the existing building at 1247 Santa Fe Drive



## Visitors

Saw 3,740 Veterans seeking assistance. Over 82% of visitors had their expectations exceeded



## Homeless Programs

Assisted 287 Veteran households experiencing homelessness move into housing



## Taxes

Reviewed Federal and state taxes, yielding \$183,093 in refunds and savings



## Legal Clinic

Provided legal assistance on 555 cases during monthly legal clinic for Veterans



## Personal Care

Styled 120+ haircuts in a single day event for Veterans experiencing homelessness



## Legal Cases

Connected \$1.5M in award amounts for Veteran benefits through legal representation



## Volunteers

Gave 1995 hours of service by receptionist and peer navigator volunteers
